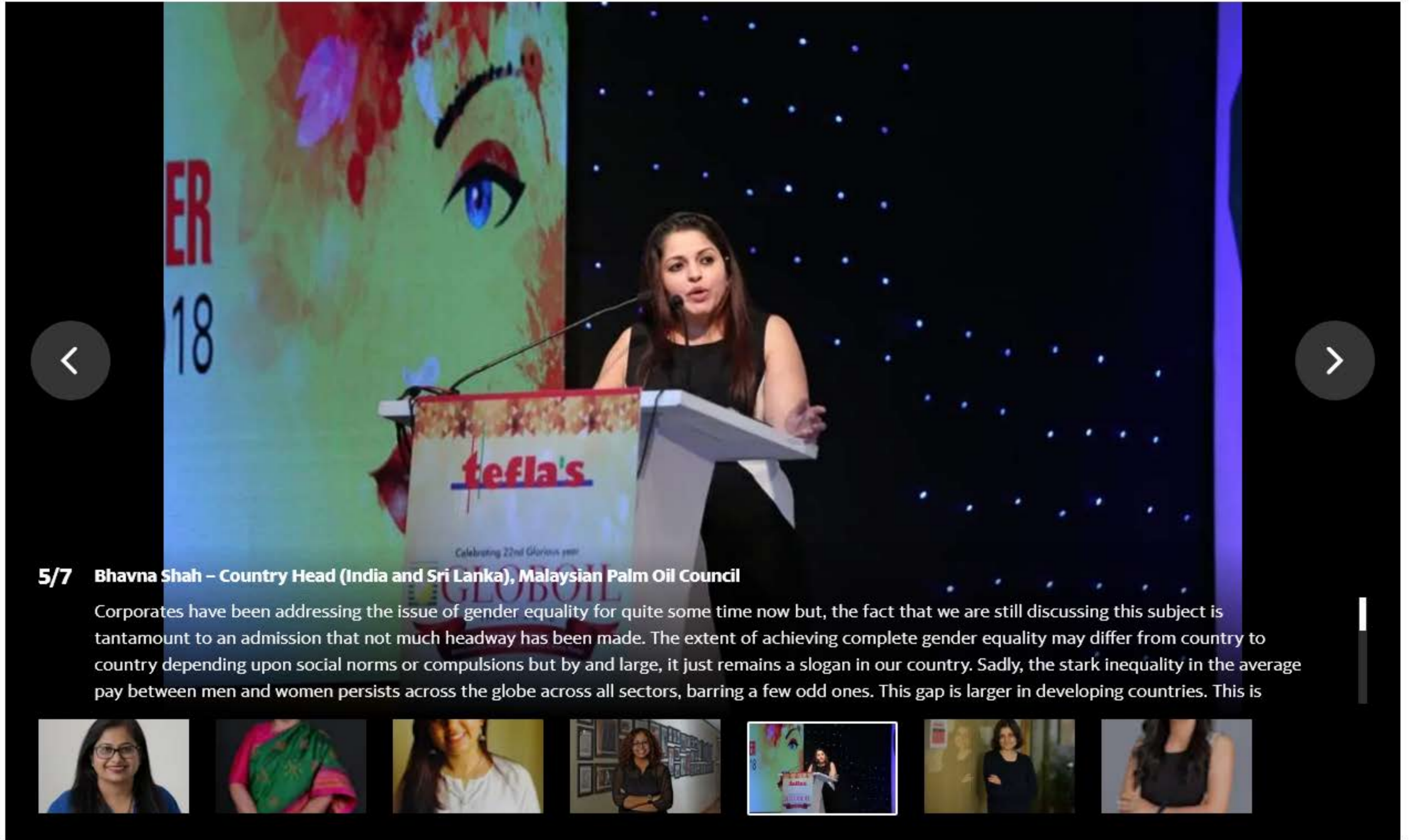


7 women achievers share their views on #Balanceforbetter
